



Crestwood Sixth form Rewards Programme

Crestwood Sixth form strives to recognise, acknowledge and reward individual achievements by students. The following are examples of areas considered to be worthy of individual recognition:

1. Consistently improved standards of work
2. Good or outstanding pieces of work
3. Outstanding effort/contributions in class and/or for prep/ extension tasks
4. Outstanding effort and/or achievement in extracurricular activities (including STEP)
5. Demonstrating effective leadership (Scholar Team)
6. Services to the school or local community

Staff will award students positives on i6 when students meet any one of the above criteria. Rewards will be awarded termly to the top 25% of students who have achieved the greatest number of positives logged on i6 in the term (please note that negatives marks will be deducted from the total of positives received, and students with attendance below 95% to date will not be eligible.).

Examples of rewards are... (Please note rewards may be subject to change)

Autumn Term– visit to the Snow Dome.

Spring Term– gift vouchers to spend in Hotel Chocolat.

Summer Term – visit to a local park for a picnic and other activities.

Where rewards are visits, these will take place on the last day of the term, and will be supervised.

Students may also be invited to apply for a Headteacher's Excellence Award at the end of Year 12. This can be awarded to students who can show they have made a positive contribution to school life and are inspirational ambassadors of Crestwood Sixth form.
