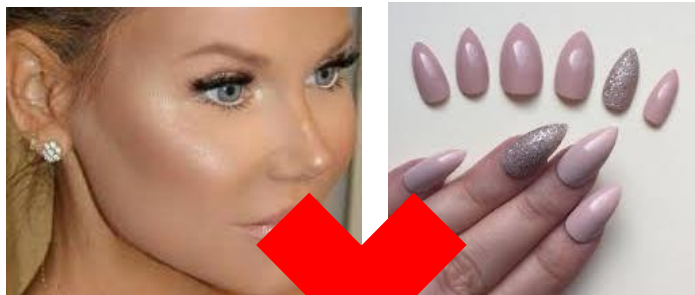

# UNIFORM

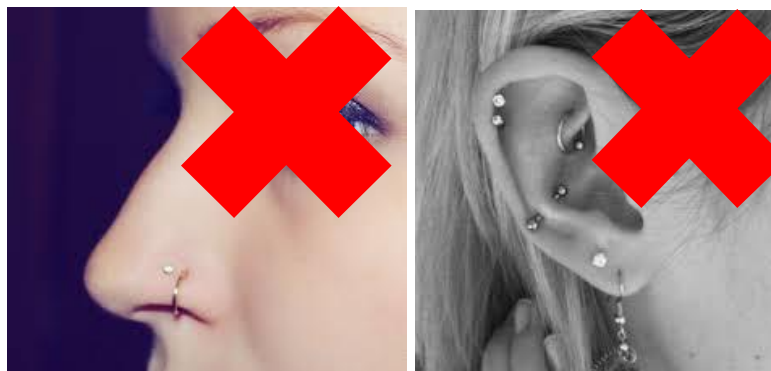


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## Jewellery

The following items are acceptable:

- One Watch



## Skirts

Must be plain black or the school tartan and no shorter than one closed hand span above the knee. No elasticated or jersey material is permitted.

## Trousers

Must be plain black and formal in style. No leggings, denim-type or figure hugging trousers are permitted.

## Shoes

Only black smart practical shoes are permitted.

## MOBILE PHONES AND MP3 PLAYERS AND HEADPHONES



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- If staff see a student with one of the above they are to remind the student that they should not be seen, and should be removed and placed in the school safe until 3.10.
- A repeat of the appearance will lead to the item being removed and placed into the safe until parents can collect.
- If a student refuses they are referred to HOY and a further sanction applied. This will include isolation and if need be a parent staff agreement about the mobile phone being brought on to school site.
