Summer School 2021 was a great success at Crestwood this year, running for five days at the start of the summer holiday from 26th July to 30th July. Our new year 7 students were invited to attend and experience a wide variety of fun educational activities. This was particularly valuable for our students this year given the time they have spent out of school throughout the year. The week was essential for students to experience the transition to secondary school. The sessions were run by Crestwood teachers and supported by TAs and sixth form students.
