BTEC SPORT – 2022 UPDATE FOR YR11

BTEC Sport has been impacted by the COVID pandemic in the same way it has impacted all other subject areas. With this in mind the exam board have made certain concessions that students are aware of following classroom conversations. Concessions are outlined below alongside a timeframe for the completion of the course.

UNIT 1 EXAM – This exam was not completed due to the pandemic. Student have however sat mock exams and these grades have been forwarded by Crestwood staff to the exam board. These have been accepted as accurate and grades have been awarded to students.

UNIT 2 PRACTICAL SPORT – This unit was taught at the end of Year 10. However due to the pandemic student work generated for this unit is not required to be completed and will not contribute towards their final grades. Staff at Crestwood have forwarded a predicted grade for this unit and this has been accepted and awarded by the exam board.

UNIT 6 LEADERSHIP IN SPORT – This unit of work is currently being taught. This unit is the most likely to be called for external assessment. Students are aware that the work generated needs to reflect target grades as closely as possible. This sampling process will be in April/May.

UNIT 3 PERSONAL FITNESS PROGRAMME -This unit of work is the 2nd most likely unit of work to be sampled. This unit will be completed and students should maximise the opportunity to obtain their best results in the coursework elements. The sampling process will be in April/May.

The sampling process is where the exam board request the work of certain students. This checks the level of work against the standard of work and achievement nationally. Unit 6 and 3 are critical in supporting the final grading decisions this year. Students should maximise their potential in these units prior to April/May sampling
