Religious Studies has been impacted by the COVID pandemic in the same way it has impacted all other subject areas. With this in mind the exam board have made certain concessions that students will be made aware of in full. The core of these concessions are outlined below.

THEMES EXAM – This exam is completely unaltered. The four themes that students will answer on in the exam are Relationships and families, Religion and life, Religion, peace and conflict and Religion, human rights and social justice.

STUDY OF RELIGIONS EXAM – These units in Christianity and Buddhism are subject to change. The exact changes in terms of subject content are too extensive to be listed in this summary but students will be given a document showing the subject content of the course when it was unaltered and what content will now be examined. However, the length of the exam and number of modules remain unaltered. They will still answer questions on Buddhism-beliefs, Buddhism-practices, Christianity-beliefs and Christianity practices.

Both exams remain 1 hour 45 minutes in duration.
